To get Started:

Lessons are pre-paid one month at a time.

So that you can calculate your fees- with this newsletter you should receive a calendar for the year.

Lesson money is due on your first class day of each month.

Lessons paid late will be subject to a \$5.00 late fee.

Lesson Prices are as Follows:

1 hour per week-\$13.50

1 ½ hours per week- \$20.25

½ hour tap only- \$7.75

¾ hour tap only-\$10.00

Unlimited is divided by levels according to the number of classes a single student takes per week.

Level 1- (2.5-3 hours)- \$121

Level 2- (3.5-4 hours)- \$147

Level 3- (4.5-5 hours)- \$164

Level 4- (5.5-6 hours)- \$179

Level 5- (6.5-7 hours)- \$195

Level 6- (7.5-8 hours)- \$211

Level 7- (8.5-9 hours)- \$227

Level 8- (9.5-10 hours)- \$243

Level 9- (10.5-11 hours)- \$262

Level 10- (11.5-12 hours)- \$274

These amounts are paid the first class day of the month, from Sept.-May in full. A payment of one 1/2 the monthly fee will be due May 15th to finish payment for the dance season. This payment is the same regardless of the number of classes in the month. If you choose the unlimited plan you may not switch back and forth from unlimited and paying by the number of classes per month.

If no one is in the office, please put your payment in the lock box hanging outside the office wall. If you have cash you can put it in an envelope, envelopes are located on the reception counter.

If you miss a class you are asked to make it up by coming to an alternate class, All students with perfect attendance, or make up all their classes will receive a medal at the end of the year. Missed lessons may not be deducted.

Appropriate dress for Class- We must insist that students wear a leotard, or tight fitting tank shirt with tights, leggings, or booty shorts to every class, no t-shirts or sweatshirts are permitted over the leotard during class. We cannot make corrections on your alignment if you wear a baggy shirt! If you have questions about appropriate attire please ask your teacher.

Our recital fundraiser was a huge success \$1010.00 was donated in the name of my mother, Pauline "Gabby" Jones to Breast Cancer Research Foundation. Thank you to all who donated.

Just so you can Plan Ahead! In October you will receive a bill for a costume, which will be due Oct. 31. Costumes are special order and can take up to 12 weeks! Last season we had many that did!

The Average costume price is \$70-\$75.

If you change classes or drop a class, please notify someone in the office so we can update your registration card and be sure that the proper costume or costumes are ordered for you!

Our policy on bad weather and dance school closings: In the event of inclement weather, we will leave a detailed message on our answering machine, one hour prior to your class with the status for the day and any information regarding future make up lessons.
