Most costumes and pieces are already on back order and cannot be replaced before they are needed for competition, pictures, or recital. Costumes will not be handed out to students who have outstanding costume fees.

5/15-5/20 Bring a Friend to dance Week- Each student may bring one friend to dance class! 6/7 and 6/8 Dress Rehearsals at Parkland High School. In January you will be given a specific rehearsal day and time

6/9 and 6/10 Recitals at Parkland high School. All Students and classes are involved in the recital.
