October is COSTUME TIME. Please be sure to fill out one Costume Form for each student. Costume form should include all costumes being ordered for that student, on the form indicate the class # and teacher of the class or classes you are purchasing for. Costume Forms and payments are due by October 31. Solo, Duo, and Trio costumes will be billed separately and Due November 15. Costumes are special order and can take up to 12 weeks to arrive. Students will be measured in class over the next couple of weeks. costume(s) - cost range (\$69-\$80 each). Dance team costumes may be slightly higher.

Each new or returning student must complete a registration form and hand it in to the office –or- use the new online registration on our website. If you add or drop a class, kindly notify someone in the office so that your registration can be updated and the proper costume(s) will be ordered. Please do not use the online form to change your registration.

JUST A REMINDER, LESSON MONEY FOR ONE MONTH OF LESSONS IS DUE AT THE FIRST CLASS DAY OF THE MONTH, FOR THE PROPER AMOUNT DUE, CHECK THE WEBSITE, CLICK ON NEWSLETTERS AND THEN CLICK ON OCTOBER LESSON FEES. AMOUNTS DUE FOR EACH MONTH ARE ALWAYS POSTED AT THE STUDIO.

WHEN WRITING A CHECK FOR MONTHLY PAYMENT, PLEASE INCLUDE YOUR CHILD'S NAME AND CLASS NUMBER IN THE MEMO!

IF YOU ARE USING THE CREDIT CARD OPTION, PLEASE EMAIL THE STUDIO WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME AND CLASS NUMBER TO ASSURE YOUR CREDIT IS CORRECTLY APPLIED.

DANCE TEAM MEMBERS ONLY- Camp/Sunday fees payment -\$470 was due at camp. Payment 1 was due September 15. If you have not paid these please remit them today. Payment 3 is Due October 15.

Registrations are still being accepted for Preschool Creative Ballet & Tap, please note there is no #39 Thursday 1:30 preschool class this season. We are still registering for all dance classes meeting on Saturday with the exception of Saturday class 61.

REMINDER: We expect that girls wear a leotard, or tight fitting dance tank, leggings, or booty shorts to every class. No t-shirts or sweatshirts are permitted over the leotard during class. We cannot make corrections to your alignment if you wear baggy clothes! Hair should be pulled back away from the face. If you have questions about appropriate attire please ask your teacher. Remember, the shoes required for your class are on the website. Click on the classes tab, open the shoes pdf all students should have the required shoes for class no later than October 15!

A NOTE ABOUT DROP OFF! WHILE WE ARE IN THIS PHASE OF LIMITING THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE IN THE BUILDING, PLEASE BRING STUDENTS TO CLASS NO MORE THAN 5 MINUTES PRIOR TO THE START OF CLASS. STUDENTS WILL ENTER THE BUILDING WHEN THE PRIOR CLASS EXITS.

If your student, or anyone in your household is ill, please use the zoom code we provided to attend class at home, and insure we keep a safe environment at the studio. If your student is unable to dance at their regularly scheduled class, please call the studio for a zoom code for an alternate class. At this time, in-person make-up classes are very limited. If you are interested in an in-person make-up class please call the studio to see which classes may be at a safe level to allow make-up students to attend, 610-398-1303.

Inclement weather: Our policy is to leave a detailed message on the answering machine one hour prior to class with the status for the day. If conditions make it unsafe for students and staff to drive to the studio, we will go directly to zoom classes to keep students learning throughout the entire season. The information will also be available on the newsletter page of the website. We do not necessarily follow school district closings. We also do not post our closings on news or radio stations.
